Abbreviated Itinerary:

Day 1 – Overnight flight to Budapest, Hungary

Day 2 – [Budapest, Hungary](#) - Transfer from the airport to the ship. Remainder of afternoon is yours to explore the city on your own.

Day 3 – [Budapest, Hungary](#) - Today visit highlights of the once separate towns of Buda and Pest, starting with Pest's [National Opera House](#) and historic [Heroes' Square](#). In Buda, walk along [Castle Hill](#) to [Fishermen's Bastion](#) and [Matthias Church](#).

Day 4 – [Bratislava, Slovakia](#) - Take a walking tour of Slovakia's charming capital. It's the only national capital that borders two other countries, Austria and Hungary. See attractions like the medieval [Town Hall](#) complex and fortifications at [Michael's Tower](#), the baroque [Jesuit Church](#) and Gothic [St. Martin's Cathedral](#).

Day 5 – [Vienna, Austria](#) - Tour the Austrian capital of Vienna. See some of the city's baroque architecture, including the world-famous [Opera House](#), [St. Stephen's Cathedral](#) and [Hofburg Palace](#).

Day 6 – [Krems, Durnstein and Melk, Austria](#) - Visit the Benedictine [Göttweig Abbey](#), a working monastery for more than 900 years. Continue by coach to Dürnstein and Melk to visit the beautiful 900-year-old [Melk Abbey](#).

Day 7 – [Linz, Austria](#) and [Český Krumlov, Czech Republic](#) Arrive in Linz this morning and set off on an all-day excursion to the beautiful Bohemian town of Český Krumlov, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Ride through the scenic Czech countryside and take a walking tour featuring the lovely historic center of the city with many baroque and Renaissance buildings, dating back hundreds of years.

Day 8 – [Passau, Germany](#) - Arrive in Passau, at the confluence of the Inn, Ilz and Danube Rivers. Walk through Old Town to see the [New Bishop's Residence](#), visit [St. Stephen's Cathedral](#) and enjoy a special concert played on Europe's largest, 17,000-pipe organ.

Day 9 – [Passau, Germany](#) - Morning disembarkation from the ship, then head to the Munich airport for flight home.

Terms and Conditions:

Deposit and Full Payment - A deposit of \$950 per person is required to confirm a reservation. Final payment will be due Travel Leaders on or before Friday, December 7, 2018. All deposits and final payments may be made by either cash, check or credit card. There are no additional service fees for credit card charges.

Cancellation Policy: For any cruise/tour booking, whether under deposit, partially paid, or paid in full, or air paid in full, the following Travel Agent or Guest-requested situations are considered cancellations and penalties will apply as noted below: changes to departure date; substitutions of itinerary; substitution of another person for original booked guest(s); or changing to a promotional fare. All cancellations must be in writing. For all air-inclusive packages cancelled after issuance of an airline ticket, the air portion of the refund, if any, will be processed only after the return of airline ticket. The following cancellation charges will be assessed for all written cancellations received prior to departure up to the scheduled time of departure: 121 days or more prior to time of departure: \$100.00 per person; 120-90 days prior to time of departure: 15% of Full Fare; 89-60 days prior to time of departure: 35% of Full Fare; 59-30 days prior to time of departure: 50% of Full Fare; 29-0 days prior to time of departure: 100% of Full Fare. Full Fare is defined as the full cost of any cruise, land or air component purchased through Travel Leaders.

Documentation IMPORTANT - Since March 1, 2010, all U.S. citizens – including minors – have been required to present a valid passport. U.S. passports must have at least 6 months minimum validity remaining upon return to the U.S. with an expiration date on or after December 14, 2019.
